

2023 Holiday Amaryllis Bulbs Under the Pecan Tree

THE Holiday "MUST HAVE!"

Our Giant Amaryllis Bulbs make the perfect gift for literally everyone! And these "no planting, no watering" bulbs are also popular for decorating... on mantles, nestled in seasonal greenery, placed atop candle pillars, or in clusters for center pieces. Blooming for months, it's the gift that keeps giving!

About the Bulbs... Our bulbs are all grown by one grower in the coastal desert valley of the Andean foothills. Once imported by their partner in the USA, Let 'Em Bloom, most are then hand-dipped in a special wax from Holland that is formulated to be flexible. We are the only retailer in North Georgia for these bulbs. (The Atlanta Botanical Gardens also purchases from Let 'Em Bloom... to decorate for the holidays.)

These giant bulbs typically produce multiple blooming stalks; each stalk has 4-8 large beautiful blooms. (The size of bulb, the size of the blooms and the number of blooms will depend on the variety.) The bulbs will bloom for months, and with proper care, will bloom annually.

No Green Thumb Needed... These bulbs are cultivated to bloom with no planting and no watering.

The "easy-care" nature of these bulbs makes them the perfect gift to brighten hospital rooms, nursing homes, assisted living, memory care, and offices!

Make a Bulb Reservation... You can reserve bulbs for pick up in November. We will set aside the bulb varieties you want – in the quantities you want – so you can count on having exactly what you need for gift-giving and decorating.

New in 2023: You may only reserve bulbs for November pickup; they will arrive in phases all month). Bulbs will be available in December, but those cannot be reserved.

How to Reserve... Complete and return the Bulb Reservation Form.

Pick Up Notice... Bulbs arrive in multiple shipments. You will be called when your reserved bulbs arrive. Bulbs must be picked up within one week, even if all varieties you've reserved have not arrived. We simply don't have space to store the reserved bulbs.

Gift Bag... We provide paper gift bags for the bulbs you are gifting; the bulbs will continue to grow in the bag until you are ready to give them away.

First Blooms... Once you see any greenery peeking out of the bulb's "neck," then you can expect the first open blooms in about 4-5 weeks! If you purchase a bulb with no green showing, it may be 6-8 weeks, but you can speed it along by placing it a warm spot. Half the fun is watching from no green to full bloom!

Blooming Cycle... The bulb blooming cycle is the period of time from when the first bloom opens until the last bloom (on the last stalk) opens. Our bulbs typically have a minimum of two blooming stalks, but more likely, they'll have three or even four. Each stalk will then have multiple blooms. The time from when the first bloom opens until the last bloom opens is typically 8-12 weeks.

Room Temperature will Impact Growth... Bulbs will sprout and bloom more *slowly* in rooms with an ambient temp *below* 70 degrees Fahrenheit. The warmer and brighter the room, the taller the stalks and the faster the blooms will open.

Bulb Care... As the blooms wilt, pinch them off. Once all blooms on the stalk have wilted, cut that stalk down to the base, being careful not to cut other stalks or leaves. Repeat throughout the blooming cycle.



The bulbs have all the energy and water stored that they need to complete the blooming cycle.

Do not add water to the bulb. Adding water to a waxed bulb may cause the bulb to mold – preventing further growth.

May Need Propping or Turning... As the bulb blooms, the water trapped inside the bulb moves into the stalks and blooms (making the Amaryllis top-heavy). You may need to provide support for the bulb to be steady. If the light source comes from one direction, then you'll want to rotate the bulb occasionally to promote straight growth.

The Gift that Keeps Giving: Once the blooming is done and no more stalks grow, DON'T THROW IT AWAY! Cut any wax away and plant the now shrunken bulb in a pot or in the ground. Let the leaves grow tall for "re-charging."

IMPORTANT INFO ABOUT THE 2023 VARIETIES & FINISHES... 2022 information is provided to remind you which bulb(s) you had last year.



Natural Bulbs (no finish)

New in 2023: We are offering two varieties in their natural, unwaxed state. Just like the Spanish Moss bulbs that have no wax coating, these bulbs will bloom with no planting and no watering. I love this stunning arrangement of Picasso unwaxed bulbs!



Picasso (white bloom with red accents)

New in 2023: Picasso will be offered as a Natural Bulb (see above) New in 2023: Picasso will be in the Silver Splatter In 2022, Picasso was offered in Silver, Silver Glitter & Gold Splatter



White Candle (solid white bloom)New in 2023: White Candle will be offered as a Natural bulb (see above)In 2022, White Candle was offered in the Spanish Moss finish



Victoria ("Christmas red" bloom) Victoria will again have the Gold Splatter finish; no change from 2022



Minerva (red bloom with white "star" center) Minerva will again have the Red Wax finish *In 2022, Minerva was also offered in the Red Glitter*

Souver

Souvereign (red bloom) Souvereign will again have the Spanish Moss finish; no change from 2022



2023 Amaryllis Bulb Reservation Form

New for 2023: We are taking reservations for bulbs in the November shipments only.

- The November shipments are staggered, usually by variety, to arrive Nov 1 15, but they could arrive later.
- When any bulb variety on your order arrives, you will be CALLED. Please consider putting 678-694-8704 in your phone so you'll know it's Under the Pecan Tree calling. You will have ONE WEEK to pick up your bulbs (because the continuous bulb shipment waves will require our storage space). Of course we will work with you if you are traveling, etc. *After the required pick-up date, the reservations will not be honored.*
- Bulbs in the November shipments should be blooming before, during and after Christmas; you can slow the growth by storing them in a cool place.
- Bulbs in the December shipments will only be sold as regular stock, first come/first serve.
- Those subscribed to the specific Amaryllis Bulb Bulletin will receive shipment alerts via email.

RESERVATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED THRU 10/15/23. Keep in mind... the later you return the form, the more likely your preferred bulbs will be reserved, meaning we cannot honor your reservation.
